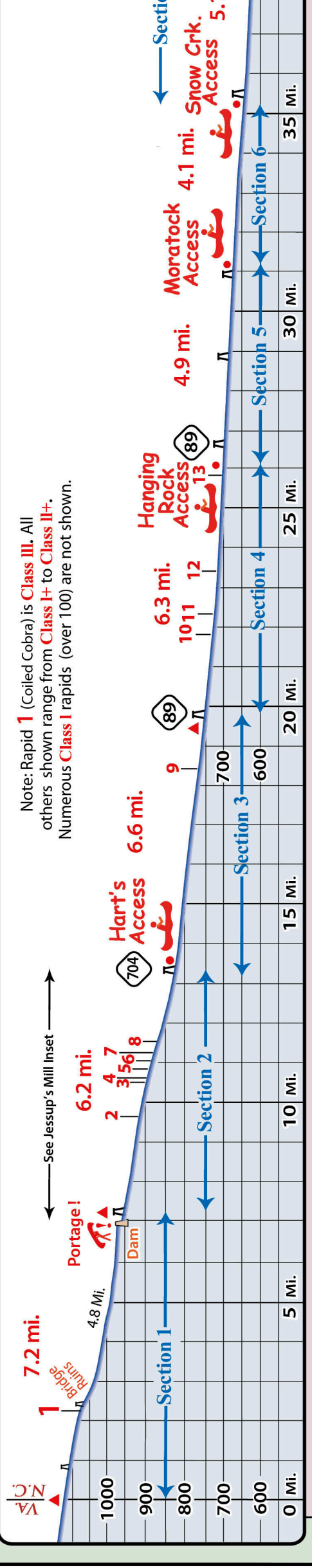


DAN RIVER PROFILE

As it meanders fifty miles across Stokes County, the Dan River falls 596 feet, or an average drop of 11.65 feet per mile. Half of that occurs between the state line and NC 704, where the drop is a more than 22 feet per mile
